INTENDED PURPOSE

The Q path Cytofix solution is a fixative commonly used in cytology. It is perfectly suited and recommended for cervical/vaginal samples. The fixative combines the coagulant qualities of alcohol to enable a better fixation of nuclear and cytoplasmic elements. The erythrocytes are lysed and therefore do not obscure the observation of the elements of interest. This fixative is only used with Turbitec technique.

- 2. It is recommended to close the spout tightly so as to avoid any leak.
